## **Notified Resource Consent Application by South Wairarapa District Council**

### **1. Purpose**

To inform the Committee that a Hearings Committee comprising Cr Rick Long and Cr Ian Buchanan was formulated to consider one resource consent application from the South Wairarapa District Council to take water from the Waiohine River for the purpose of supplying public water to the towns of Greytown and Featherston.

### **2. Application process**

One application for a water take was lodged with the Wellington Regional Council. The application was notified on 11<sup>th</sup> August 1999. Six submissions were received. The need for a hearing was waived as draft conditions recommended in the officers report were signed off by all submitters and the applicant.

### **3. Decision**

The Hearing Committee granted the consent subject to the conditions recommended within the officers report, at a meeting on 3<sup>rd</sup> November 1999. No submitters or the applicant were present at the meeting. No appeals against the decision have been lodged to date.
