#### **2.1 Regional Land Transport Strategy review**

##### 2.1.1 CBD Corridor study

A Terms of Reference has been developed and it is the matter of another report on this agenda.

##### 2.1.2 Key policies and assumptions

Initial work has been completed and this is the matter of a separate report to the Committee. Further consideration of this topic will also occur at a workshop for the Committee on 1 July 2004.

##### 2.1.3 Regional Pedestrian Strategy

This has been developed by a technical group and has completed its consultation phases. The strategy is the subject of a separate report that seeks the Committee's consideration of submissions and adoption of the amended strategy.

##### 2.1.4 Regional Road Safety Strategy

Again a technical group has developed this. It is also the matter of a separate report seeking the Committee's agreement to release the draft strategy for consultation.

## **2.2 Cycle strategy implementation**

### **2.2.1 Regional cycle maps**

Terralink has been engaged to develop and produce cycle route maps for the region. There will be three maps covering:

- Wellington / Wellington CBD
- Hutt Valley / Wairarapa
- Porirua / Kapiti

Distribution of the maps will commence early in the next financial year.

### **2.2.2 Strategic cycle network review**

Bullen Consultations have completed a review of the strategic cycle network and have recommended development priorities. This will now be circulated to RCAs and discussed at the next Regional Cycle Forum.
