Request for information 2024-073

I refer to your request for information dated 11 April 2024 which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 11 April 2024. You have requested the following:

“A copy of CCTV footage on the Tranzurban bus (Route 120, number 3220) from 12:15pm to 12:45pm on Monday 8 April 2024.”

Greater Wellington’s response

We have refused your request under section 17(g) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) on the basis that the information requested is not held by Greater Wellington and there are no grounds for believing that the information is either–

- (i) Held by another local authority or a department or Minister of the Crown or organisation; or
- (ii) Connected more closely with the functions of another local authority, or a department or Minister of the Crown or organisation.

CCTV footage for buses on the Metlink network is recorded and managed by the relevant bus operator. A request for this CCTV footage can be made directly to that bus operator – in this case, Tranzurban – noting that there is no legislative obligation on that organisation to provide that information.

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this letter, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.

Please note that it is our policy to proactively release our responses to official information requests where possible. Our response to your request will be published shortly on Greater Wellington's website with your personal information removed.
